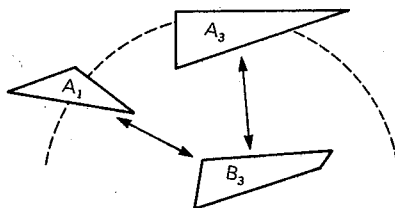
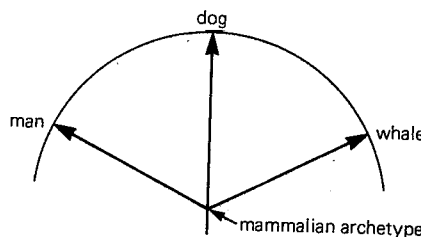


Where the representative of one class happens to resemble the representative of another class the resemblance is only superficial and not indicative of any sort of profound relationship. For example, triangle A₃ and quadrilateral B₃ resemble each other, but both are still perfectly representative of their respective classes.
